Many of you know that last summer didn't go quite as any of us hoped or intended, and we are as disappointed as you that things were not near the level that we want to maintain for you, your family and your guests.

This coming summer will be our 70th Consecutive Swim Season, and we are planning to make a number of improvements this spring. For the last few years we have been focusing on water chemistry/quality/clarity and related physical plant improvements, and this preseason we will be focused on more of the visual and experiential matters/projects that contribute to your pool enjoyment: Curb appeal and landscape, restroom/dressing room appearance and cleanliness, pool appearance and ladders(repainting both pools and repairing/replacing ladders), replacing old/worn furniture and increasing the number of chairs and lounges, improving front desk interactions, management presence and response, and improvements to lessons scheduling, communications, instructor training and class delivery. We also have a few "This would be nice..." items on our to-do list, like re-establishing audio capabilities for music and PA purposes, adding umbrellas to some of the deck in areas not shaded otherwise, and brightening up the lobby and front desk/concessions area.

We are also working on a full re-design of the website to be more user friendly, especially in mobile mode, and hope to have it ready to go live around April 1. Our amazing marketing team stepped up last fall and enthusiastically took on brainstorming and planning for branding and outreach to kick off our 70th Swim Season in a Big Way and creating events and experiences to continue the celebration all summer.

Most of you know that the pool's operations are funded almost entirely by membership income. We don't receive financial support from the city, a neighborhood group or any other organization. The pool is funded and perpetuated primarily by its members. Many thanks to those who answered the call in August to take care of this year's member enrollment super-early! The best ways members can help the pool succeed are to renew their memberships early, year after year, and share the "secret" of the pool with others. This year's membership goal is 400 paid memberships and early enrollment is the best way to help us get more done before the season begins while giving members the BEST RATES we can offer!
